















# The First Press Conference of the Expedition SOUL OF THE CASPIAN project for the study and conservation of the Caspian seal

On October 26, 2021 at 12.30 (UTC+4), a press conference on the launch of Soul of the Caspian Ecological Project for the Study and Conservation of the Caspian Seal will be held at the VIP-hall of B.M. Kustodiev International Airport. The project has been developed by Clean Seas Foundation in cooperation with leading experts on marine mammals from A.N. Severtsov Institute of Ecology and Evolution of the Russian Academy of Sciences with the support of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment of the Russian Federation.

The first expedition starts this autumn. On an amphibious aircraft La-8, the scientific and film crew will fly along the Russian coast of the Caspian Sea according pre-built routes. At the helm - Hero of Russia Valery Tokarev, the main pilot of all Clean Seas Foundation's air expeditions, cosmonaut, 1st class test pilot.


At the second stage, the expedition team and inspectors of the Astrakhanskiy State Nature Reserve, will go out to sea on speed boats to Maliy Zhemchuzhniy Island to install satellite transmitters on Caspian seals and take bio-samples. All these are just the first steps of the project «Soul of the Caspian». There is still a lot of work ahead to study the current status of the Caspian seal population and develop a strategy for Caspian seals conservation.

The Caspian seal is one of the smallest seals in the world. The seal is the only mammal in a salt lake, which is called the Caspian Sea, and also an indicator of its ecosystem. Over the past 100 years, the number of this marine mammal has decreased by 90 %. In 2008, the Caspian seal was red-listed by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (the IUCN) as Endangered species. And in 2020, the Caspian seal was inscribed into the Red Data Book of the Russian Federation.

Ecologists and biologists of all the Caspian states have long sounded the alarm about the decline in the number of the Caspian seal population and mass mortality recorded in the past few years in Dagestan.

Our ultimate goal is to help the Caspian seal escape from the pages of the Red Data Book and feel comfortable in the vastness of the Caspian Sea.














## **The Expedition Tasks:**

- Collection / updating of scientific data on the distribution, key habitats and population relationships of seals;
  - Formation of a map of the Caspian seal haul-out sites;
- Identification of factors influencing the degradation of the Caspian seal population, including anthropogenic pollution in the habitats of seals;
  - Exchange of data on studies carried out in other Caspian states.


